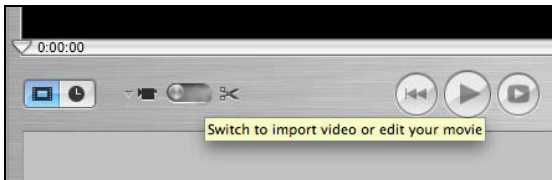


## Digitizing Video with iMovie HD

1. Put tape in camcorder and connect it to Mac mini or External Drive via firewire (IEEE1394) cable.
2. Turn the camcorder on and switch to “VCR” or “Play/Edit” mode (you have to cycle through camera modes on the new camcorders).
3. Launch iMovie HD. Create a new project, save named project in the directory with your first name on the *tempvideo* drive.
4. Set the *Import/Edit* slider to the Import (to the left)



5. Play the tape.
6. Click the *Import* button to begin capturing video, click it again to stop recording. (If you click *Import* again after having stopped the recording, a new clip will be triggered.)
7. Save the project
8. Quit iMovie HD
9. Find the project you saved on the temp drive, right (or ctrl-)click on it and choose *show package contents*
10. Double-click the *Media* subdirectory, to see the video clip. Rename the clip (e.g., clip01.dv → NSF\_yr3\_S7.dv) and move it to the desired directory on the temp video drive.
11. Launch *RITCode* to analyze the video.
